



Chikara Weed Control

A residual herbicide for use on natural or permeable surfaces not intended to bear vegetation and amenity vegetation [around] - established shrub beds. Chikara controls most grass and broad leaved weeds as they emerge but will not control established weeds. Where the site has established weeds Chikara should always be tank mixed with glyphosate. Chikara is supplied in 50g and 150g packs with a measuring cup. One rate of use, 150g/ha, LERAP B, one application per year.

Application Rate:

Chikara mix for a 15 litre knapsack using the recommended equipment.

- Fill tank with 10 litres of water
- Add 15 grams of Chikara
- Add 500ml of 360 glyphosate [400ml of 450 glyphosate]
- Top up to 15 litres with clean water
- Shake thoroughly to mix
- All the above nozzles have an application rate of 150lt/ha @ 1 bar pressure
- 10 knapsacks = 1 hectare (10000 m²)
