

Coir Pallets

Coir Pallets are manufactured from 100% biodegradable virgin coir fibre's and preplanted at a specialist UK nursery using only UK native wetland plants. Coir Pallets shall be planted at a rate of 20 plants per m² and grown outdoors for a minimum of 12 weeks during the growing season and until roots are well established.

Coir Pallet nettings shall be manufactured from a 3mm coir rope in a 50mm sq mesh opening, the pallets shall be filled with virgin coir fibre typically 100mm to 150mm in length and evenly distributed; depth shall be a minimum of 50mm with an approx weight of 3kgs per m² dry.

Typical Plant Species Available

Carex acutiformis (Lesser Pond Sedge), Juncus effusus (Soft Rush), Lythrum salicaria (Purple Loosestrife), Iris pseudacorus (Yellow Flag Iris) Phalaris arundinacea (Reed Canary Grass), Caltha palustris (Marsh Marigold), Glyceria maxima (Sweet Reed Grass), Myosotis scorpioides (Water Forget Me Not), Ranunculus flammula (Lesser Spearwort), Alisma plantago-aquatica (Water Plantain), Mentha aquatica (Water mint), Phragmites australis (Common Reed)
