

Which Covamat do I need?

Covamat Plus

Covamat Plus improves poor soil conditions due to the incorporation of a specially developed organic fertilisers and dry micro-organisms. This seed, fertiliser and dry micro-organism combination helps to guarantee the best possible germination results for the grass seed within our Covamats. The mulch layer is a combination of coir dust, chopped straw, chopped hay and coir waste for seed embedment and vegetation enhancement.

Type 1: 100% blanket suitable for slopes up to 30 degrees

Type 2: 50% straw/50% coir blanket suitable for slopes up to 45 degrees

Type 3: 100% coir fibre suitable for slopes over 45 degrees



Covamat Maintenance

Like all plants grasses require nutrients, water, oxygen and light. Remove one of these and the plant will die. If the weather is dry for a long period, watering may be required, especially in the early stages of root development. For successful germination and grass establishment the blanket must be in contact with the underlying soil. A level, weed and debris free surface is required. Don't stretch the blanket during installation and install additional pins or pegs if necessary or apply a thin layer (5mm-10mm) of soil over the blanket. Re-pin any loose or damaged areas as part of your maintenance check.
